The study group will now be on a forum. The forum is part of Tim Torell's website.

<http://digitalwildlifeimages.com/> Then click the FORUMS tab.

If you want to participate in the study group you must first join the forum then post your image. The forum is free to Reno Photo Club members and non members alike.

There are many advantages to the forum.

You see other images as they are posted, you can add, edit, or delete your own comments and images. Read comments from others as they are posted. Ask and answer question about images, how the image was created, where the image was taken and so on.

This forum like all forums has one drawback. Any image posted on the web can be copied, even if the host tells you the images can't be copied, they can... Therefore I recommend you post a small file size image 700 pixels on the widest side.

Also place a copyright in the lower right corner of the image.

With the millions of images on the web the chance of someone wanting one of my images is highly unlikely, so I'm not worried. I have more to gain by posting my images and getting constructive feedback from you than I have to loose if someone wants to copy my image.

I look forward to seeing your images on the forum, we can all learn from one another.

## **Digital Before & After Program - May 7th!**

*This is an opportunity for club members to show what they can do with an image in the computer.  
Show what you started with and what the final result is after spending minutes or days on the computer.*

Anything from a simple crop to multiple layers and anything in between. Hopefully, we'll see some great images and maybe we'll all come away with new ideas about what can be done in the computer to create outstanding images.

-Up to 8 images for each participant (each set of before/after counts as one image)

-Image size to be limited to 1024 pixels on the widest side, with file size limited to 200kb. Jpeg format. If you combine parts of more than one image, you can have up to 3 "before" images in a set, but please limit file size of multiple "before" images to 100kb each.

-Please name the files with your initials and number them in increasing order of preference, with no 8 as your favorite image, in case we have to reduce the number of images per person. For example, I would name my least favorite "before" image mch1a and the matching "after" image mch1b.

-Be prepared to briefly discuss what you did to achieve the final result. Discussion should be limited to around 30 seconds for each image. That way, 80 images would take a little over 40 minutes to present.

-Deadline for getting your images to me is the May slide night, 4/25/08. They can be submitted on a CD or by email to [m.horsley@sbcglobal.net](mailto:m.horsley@sbcglobal.net). If you give me a CD, please put your name on it and it will be returned to you.
